TEN WAYS TO DELEGATE

delegate (del.e.gate) v.: To intrust to the care or management of another; to transfer; to assign; to commit.

1. Create a household chore list and spread it between each member of the family
2. Host a potluck dinner once per week - all you need to make is one dish for dinner!
3. Consolidate errands - hit the post office, grocery store and Target in one trip rather than spread throughout the day
4. Trade childcare with another family
5. Use milk, produce deliver or online grocery delivery
6. Take advantage of pick-up/drop-off dry cleaning services
7. Hire a house cleaner - even if just once a month
8. Take part in a carpool for your child's {many} activities
9. If you commute to work, take public transportation. This will free up all that driving time for you to spend doing other things {reading, checking email, knitting}
10. Use online banking - plug in your monthly bills and let the bank pay them {on time} each month
